
DRAFT CLIMBING GUIDE TO TAIWAN'S PREMIER ROCK CLIMBING AREA: LONGDONG 龍词 "DRAGON'S CAVE"





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
I. INTRODUCTION

The Longdong climbing area is located 50km northeast of Taibei on Taiwan's northeast coast between the port of Jilong and the small village of Fulong (renowned for it's beach and deadly riptides, which took 10 lives in 1992). The rock is a generally solid sandstone which lines the coast for about 1 1/2 miles. Aside from climbing, this area is also popular for diving and fishing.

II. GETTING TO LONGDONG

From Taibei: Use Taiqi keyun 台汽客運

Go to the "Taibei north station" 台北北京 located diagonally across from the northwest corner of main Taibei Station. To get to the north station, start at the NW corner of Taibei Station, cross the elevated footbridge both over Zhengzhou Rd.東州 (the road behind the main station) and over Chengde Rd.永 後以 (the left road). Turn right immediately at the bottom of the steps into the building and you're there!



Name of Bus Co.: Taiqi keyun 台汽客運

Buying the Ticket: Go to the first ticket window on the left and purchase a ticket for \$NT69 to Longdong Harbor (pronounced Longdong gang 龍词達). You are going on a bus marked either Yilan 資富 or Luodong 羅東 above the windshield.

Getting on the Bus: Line up at the gate marked #1. The bus boards 5 min. before departure.


Departure times: 6:20am, 6:40, 7:10, 7:40, 8:00, 8:40, 9:05, 9:30, 9:55, 10:20, 10:35, 10:50, 11:15, 11:40....

Time to Destination: Usually 1 hr. and 20 min. Rush hour time is about 2 hours. Return time is at least 2 hours and can be 3-4 hours if you return between 4:30 and 7:30 on Sunday evening!


Seating: Usually seats are first come first serve, but in order to accommodate long distance travelers, some seats are reserved by number. There is no way to tell if anyone has an assigned seat until that person bumps you from your seat (they will show you their ticket). This is no problem if you go early and the bus is not crowded. If the bus is crowded and there are no seats available, you can either sit on the far rear platform or will have to stand until someone gets off. If you're standing, you don't have a hope of getting a seat for at least 40 minutes when the bus reaches Jilong. There is a remote possibility that someone will bump you with a reserved seat when they get on in Jilong, but this is uncommon. I suppose if you really wanted a guaranteed seat, you could spend the money on a ticket all the way to Yilan!

Getting There From Jilong: Use Jilong keyun 基隆客運

Take a local white bus with orange stripes from under the elevated sidewalk on the west side of the street in front of Jilong Station. The extravagant cost is \$NT43. Time: 30 min.



Get off after the 3rd tunnel on the far side of the harbor after the bus starts up the hill!




The bus from Taibei takes the highway past the Grand Hotel and then through the first tunnel arriving in Jilong. Then the bus goes past various wharves and heads SE through Jilong and out along the coast. The third tunnel is just after a quaint little fishing port of Bitou. Stand up and put on your packs while in the third tunnel—when you emerge you'll be at Longdong Harbor. The bus goes all the way to the opposite side of the harbor and will just start up the hill before the stop. Make sure to give the driver your ticket when you get off. For directions from here, see "Hiking into Longdong" section below.

If you miss this stop and the bus goes over the hill, get off at the next stop where you'll see a large resort on the left. This is the approach to the "Back Door" area anyway, so climb here or go back! You can hike all the way from the Back Door to the School Gate along the bottom of the cliffs, but be careful at the one traversing section that requires a 5.5 boulder move. There is a lot of exposure here with wicked fall potential!

III. HOW TO RETURN FROM LONGDONG

There are two ways to return to Taibei. Flag the first bus that comes along. If it says "Wang Taibei" 往台北 on the front, the final stop is Taiqi North Station, right where you boarded. This bus costs \$NT69.

If the bus you flag is white with two orange stripes, it's a local bus and costs \$NT43. The final stop is at Jilong Station, just before the elevated sidewalk. The harbor is on the right. Walk up the stairs and over the road toward the station.



Buy the ticket for the Taibei bus at the set of windows on the right side for \$NT28 (there is a sign on cardboard next to the correct window announcing the price). The bus leaves from gate #2 every 5-8 minutes for its final destination of Taibei Station. Due to local traffic along Zhongxiao East Rd., the return can take between 1 1/2 hrs. and 2 1/2 hrs. Leaving before 6pm on Saturday night is a good idea since the traffic is lighter.

Note #1: The return on Sunday will inevitably take 2-3 hours since everyone and their brother is out for this weekly holiday.

Note #2: If it is raining all day Sunday in Taibei the traffic will be light like Saturday's! Usually it doesn't rain in Longdong unless the weather comes in from the west, though, so go climbing anyway and you'll likely have a reasonably dry time!

Returning by Train:

The train station is easily identified by the electronic clock outside on the wall. The train takes about 40 minutes to Taibei Station and is the best choice on busy Sundays if you're already in Jilong. Note that this is also traffic "stress-free"!!


Avoiding Taibei Station on Return:

You can take a bus directly from Jilong Bus station to Taida 台大 (get off at Gongguan公館) for NT\$27. Buy the ticket when you get on the bus that heads for Xindian 新庭. Line up for this bus outside the station at the very head of the long line of buses.

Spelling Key: Use at your own discretion!


You may ask, what's the deal with the screwy spelling system?! Well, I've been studying Chinese for 8 years and know 5 different systems, and the one used in Taiwan is really off the wall. So I've used the mainland Chinese "Hanyu pinyin" system that is taught by just about all American Universities and renders the most consistent pronunciations for the native English speaker. The Taiwanese will probably get their act together sometime in the future and change the present wacky system, but don't hold your breath.... Anyway, here's a small translation table:

FROM THE BUS STOP: HIKE INTO LONGDONG


Cross the street and go down the path right of the bus shelter. After passing the chicken coops make an immediate right and pass the small house and piles of Taiwan beer bottles.



Go through the first of the dragon gates.



Take the short cut right to the paved road that follows the cove. Walk up the cove to the second dragon and gazebo. These are right in front of the Zhang's 流花点 (a.k.a. Mr. Well) small store. Get your water and cookies here! The Zhang's offer noodles, ramen style, and will put out a table for you and your friends. On rainy days they will even put a table inside for you!



Walk past the fishing fields (where the divers put in) and up onto the rock path on the right.




Go in and turn right at the first "V".

ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS: SCHOOL GATE AREA

I. DECEIVING OVERHANGS WALL 馬扁人的牆

Try the climbs and you'll understand the name!

1. Round Z, 5.10d; round holds up to diagonal crack.

2. Thinset, 5.11a; continuous thin crack up .

- 3. Emergence, 5.11b; climb diagonal holds 1.5m right bolts.
- 4. Out the Groove, 5.11a; Start in the groove, climb out to 3 bolts.
- 5. In the Groove, 5.10a; Start at corner in grove and climb the arete past the first bolt, and continue up the right-leaning flake.

II. SEA OF CRACKS

- 6. **Seacrack**, 5.7; the main right hand wide crack up to a left curving finger crack.
- 7. Boltface Right, 5.9+; the 2 bolts and continue up to the right ending at "Out the Grove" bolt belay.
- 8. Boltface Left, 5.9; finish #7 by going up and left, but stay right of the arching crack.
- 9. **Boltface Overhang**, 5.9; finish #7 by using the arching crack to the overhang and turn the overhand directly.
- 10. Moby, 5.6; the large crack 2m left of Boltface.
- 11. Easy Arete, 5.4; the arete 2m left of Moby.
- 12. Easy Corner, 5.3; the corner right of Surprise face.
- 13. Surprise Face, 5.11+; top-rope the thin face using the left hand crack for only one hold before finishing mid-face.
- 14. Right Surprise, 5.10d; natural protection up the right crack without using the left crack(5.10b). The second overhang is the crux (5.10d) following the thin right crack.
- 15. Cross Surprise, 5.9+; use both the left and right cracks.
- 16. Left Surprise, 5.11a; the left crack exclusively.
- 17. Daji's Awesomely Strenuous Surprise Left Layback, 5.10; Layback all the way up the shallow left dihedral using the right wall for a stem.
- 18. Oh! Arete Surprise Start, 5.10d; Reach! From the Surprise left crack reach up and over to the arete.
- 19. Oh! Arete Left Start, 5.10a; Hand traverse right on the Oh! overhang and follow the arete to the top.
- 20. Oh! 5.8; clip the 6 bolts on the face all the way to the large crack past the bush. This route has 2 rap bolts at the top and is the preferred method of descending the Sea of Cracks.
- 21. Oh No! 5.11?; the relatively blank face left of Oh! I think Yum Yum did this on top-rope.



- Walk It Down, 5.11b; clip bolts to arete using holds around 41. corner. #3 Friend and small TCU's pro top exposed section.
- Talk it Down, 5.12; same as #41 but squeeze the arete only 42.
- Nowhere Man, 5.11c/d; main face; #4 Rock between 2nd and 3rd 43. bolts, #2 or #2 1/2 Friend at horizontal; bolts to top. 無所畏
- 43a. Nowhere Man Left, 5.11d; turn upper overhang to left
- Road to Nowhere, 5.11b; start Nowhere Man and go left. V-groove, 5.8; awkward little dihedral.
- 45.
- Little Creatures Arete, 5.10a; directly up the arete
- 47. Television Man, 5.9; climb face and small overhangs
- Noname, 5.4; short east-facing face 48.


